Bills of Interest:

<u>LEOFF 1 Termination (HB 2034)</u> – Passed out of House Appropriations last week and is currently in House Rules. This bill may be considered necessary to implement the budget and have a deadline of April 27th.

<u>Closed Retirement Plans (SB 5085)</u> – Had a hearing in House Appropriations but was not exec'd out. This bill may be considered necessary to implement the budget and have a deadline of April 27th.
